EXCUSED ABSENCE LETTER DUE TO EASTERN ORTHODOX GOOD FRIDAY OBSERVANCE

To: All Teachers and School Administrators

To whom it may concern,

The Eastern Orthodox Church quite often celebrates Easter on a different Sunday than Western Churches. This celebration can fall one week, or in some instances several weeks afterward.

Of course, this necessarily means our Good Friday is also celebrated on a different date. For example, for the present ecclesiastical year of 2024, Eastern Orthodox Good Friday falls on Friday, May 3rd. This is an important event in the life of our faith and culture.

In our religious and cultural tradition Good Friday is a day that all Orthodox Christians are obligated to attend church services which begin in the morning, extend through the afternoon and continue into the evening.

We therefore request that you excuse the absence of the Orthodox Christian student that attends your school and bears this letter, for Eastern Orthodox Good Friday which falls this year on Friday, May 3rd.
